

# Using Canon XF305 Camera Files in Premiere Pro CC

## Copying CF Card files to Hard Drive

1. On your external hard drive, in your Story Project folder, create a folder named "VIDEO".
2. In a new window, click on your CF card which is usually named "CANON XF".
3. Copy the folder "CONTENTS" into the "VIDEO" folder. **Do not rename this folder.**
4. After files have copied over, eject the CF card.

## Importing Video Files into Premiere

1. Click on the "Media Browser" tab next to the "Project" tab where all of your files are.
2. In the "Media Browser", click on your external hard drive, and navigate to the VIDEO folder you created in your Story Project folder.
3. Your video files will slowly populate one by one.
4. Highlight all of the files you want to use by either holding down the "Ctrl" key and clicking on the files, or if you want to select them all, press "Ctrl + A" (Select All).
5. Once clips are selected, Right Click and choose "Import". This will import the selected files into your project.
6. Click on the "Project" tab and you will see the clips that you have just imported.
7. Remember to modify the audio for your clips!
