
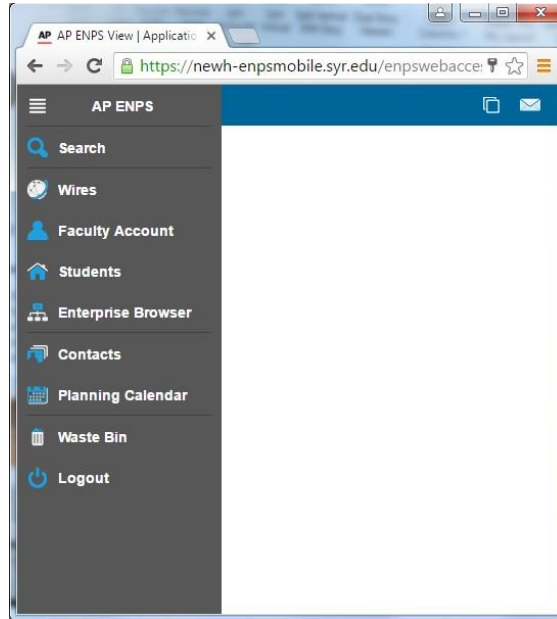



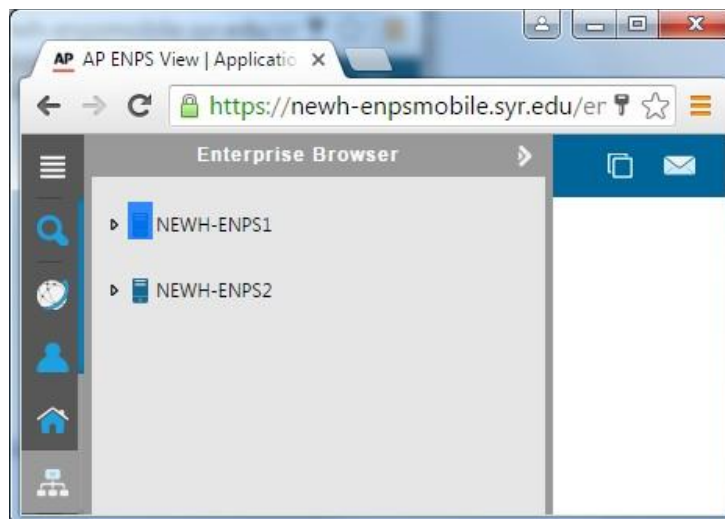
# ENPS MOBILE GUIDE

Login to ENPS (can save login for faster future use.)

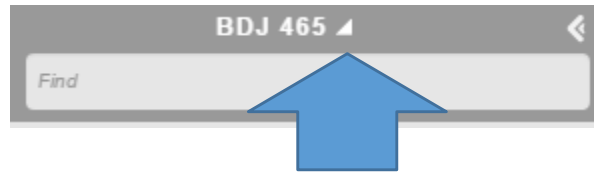
 The **MENU** icon shows you full description of choices:

**NEW STORY** icon to create new stories.

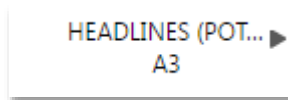
